At least one member of the body or at least one staff person or other designee must be present at that physical location. Each member who attends electronically must identify himself or herself when the meeting is convened and must be able to hear and be heard throughout the meeting. Any voting that occurs at the meeting that is not unanimous must be done by roll call. 1 V.S.A. § 312(a)(2)(C).
