APPLICATION FOR WATER SERVICE**INSTRUCTIONS:**

Applications for service are to be made on forms provided by the district. Application shall be made by the owner of the property to be served. Upon acceptance of service to the property the owner shall be responsible for payment of all water charges rendered to the property. Application should be made at least one month prior to the date the connection is required. The approval of applications will normally be contingent upon the existence of a water main in the public way with the capacity to carry the increased demand. The applicant is responsible for obtaining any and all rights of way necessary in connection with the service.

All service connections shall be installed under the supervision of the Water Superintendent and in accordance with district specifications at the expense of the customer. All services shall be of Type 'K' copper - ¾" or larger, CTS plastic - 1" or larger, C-900 or ductile iron pipe. See the by-laws for further information on rules of the district. A copy will be provided upon request.

FEES:

The applicant for a service connection will be required to deposit, in advance of construction, a sum equal to the estimated cost of the installation of the service as determined by the Prudential Committee. When the installation is completed, any excess deposit will be refunded. If the cost exceeds the deposit, then before the water is turned on the applicant will pay the deficiency.

In addition to the above deposit, a tapping fee of \$300.00 and a capacity replacement charge of \$3.00/gallon/day based on flow quantities determined by the State of Vermont as listed in Chapter 8 of the Wastewater System and Potable Supply Rules shall be charged. The tapping fee is used to offset the cost of the tapping equipment and labor, while the capacity replacement monies are held in an account to offset the cost of additional water supplies and/or storage facilities in the future.
